

Town of Mount Pleasant, Green County
Summary of Amendments to Driveway Ordinance 1-98
(as amended 17th of September 2018)

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Mount Pleasant in Green County signed on 17th of September 2018, the amended version of the town driveway ordinance # 1-98. In summary, the amendments conform the ordinance to procedures adopted by the board previously.

As amended, the ordinance provides that applicants for town driveway permits must complete both the town driveway permit application and the Code of Country Living form. After obtaining board of supervisors' approval of the driveway, the applicant may proceed to construct the driveway to town driveway specifications, except for the final layer of gravel. When the driveway is ready for inspection, the applicant must notify the town building inspector, who will inspect the driveway and notify the board chair of the results.

Following the addition of the final layer of gravel, the applicant will notify the town building inspector, who will do the final inspection and inform the town chair of results. If the inspection is satisfactory, the town board chair will direct the town clerk to refund the security deposit portion of the fee, less any town expenses, including building inspector inspection fees related to the driveway.

Fees for driveway permits are not amended. Penalties for violation of the ordinance are not amended, and include a fine of three times the fee charged by the permit application, whether or not the fee has been paid. If the landowner does not make corrections to the land required by the town board as a result of a violation of the ordinance, the town may make the changes and charge the landowner.
